 - Due to innovative genetic sequencing, virus researchers are now having a great time partly because they can easily distinguish disease-causing microorganisms.

- The Amazon Rainforest is widely known for the existence of wonderful plants rather than the incredible animal species found there.
 - It is well known that the Amazon Rainforest contains a high quantity of plants together with an increasing number of animal species.
 - The Amazon Rainforest is notable to many with its large collection of plants and animal species that cannot be found anywhere else.
 - In addition to an abundant number of animal species, the Amazon Rainforest is known for its stunning variety of plants.
